Description: Special Lecture given by Dr. Amitava Chakraborty, Prof. of MIL, Delhi University. Organised by Bengali Department, Ramthakur college on 8/4/2022 at 11.30am.

Prof. Amitava Chakraborty teaches Bengali and Comparative Indian Literature at the Department of Modern Indian Languages and Literary Studies, University of Delhi. He has taught at Tripura University and Tokyo University of Foreign Studies. He specializes in Literary and Cultural Theory and has several publications on Postmodernism, Uttaradhunikatabad, and the Swarajist Paradigm. He has published Bengali and English poetry and Bengali and English translations from Assamese, Japanese (jointly) and Tamil. He is the founder General Secretary of the International Society of Bengal Studies. He has received various awards including Sadhana Bhattacharya Researcher Award, International Society for the History of Rhetoric Fellowship, and Maimansingha Geetika Centenary Honor. He is also a trade union activist. He was the Secretary, Tripura University Teacher's Association and elected teacher's representative to the Delhi University Academic Council.
