The COVID-19 pandemic has given wings to the work from home culture as people across the world are forced to stay at home to prevent the spread of the virus. At this outset, Ramthakur College, Tripura had organized a three-day International Conference (virtual) on the ‘Emerging Issues in Business and Management’ has been during 6th to 8th October, 2021.
